We are currently in Phase 2 of development in the Park. Phase 2 Improvements include the following:

- Basketball Court
- Pickle Ball Courts
- 2 U-10 play fields
- Parking Lot (paved)
- Amenities to include: Pet waste stations, garbage receptacles and benches.



Funding from these Improvements are provided by:

Also, underway this September/October

- 35-Foot-Wide Riparian Buffer planting of trees and shrubs
- A planting of wildflower Meadow buffer along the southern border of the property.

Funding for the Buffer, Meadow and maintenance of plantings is provided by the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay.

Future Projects include:

- Playground for 8 -12-year-old (Grant application was completed and submitted to the Commonwealth Financing Authority under their Parks, Open Space a recreation Grant Funding Program)
- Baseball Field Future Phase
- A large multipurpose field
- Improvements to the existing Club House

Stream Restoration Phase 2:

 Through a Grant from York County Stormwater Consortium funding for the Stream Restoration for Phase 2 was provided. Phase 2 Stream Restoration Project is in engineering design and permitting. A grant will be sought to construct the Restoration Project.
